Applying for MA: History Medieval Studies Conservation of Cultural Heritage

The School of History and Heritage is pleased to be able to offer up to three bursaries, by competition, to students who wish to undertake one of the MA degree programmes offered by the School (MA History, MA Medieval Studies, MA Conservation of Cultural Heritage).

There is no fixed allocation per programme; bursaries will be awarded to candidates who submit the best applications.

The School bursaries will cover fees up to £6320. Successful applicants wishing to take the MA over two years will receive up to £3160 per year, with no increase in the second year to match any increase in fees. **The exact sum offered in each case will be communicated to the successful candidate(s).**

Students are required to have applied for their MA programme of choice before submitting an application.

The deadline for applications is Friday, 7th May 2021 at 4pm, and a decision will be made before the end of May. Successful applicants will be expected to confirm that they accept both their place on a programme and the bursary shortly after that. In the event that a candidate does not accept the bursary, it may be offered to another applicant who has accepted a place.
