## Introduction

The University of Lincoln College of Arts is pleased to announce a merit-based scholarship for a high achieving UK-permanent resident of a Black, Asian or Minority Ethnic background. An award of £2500 will be paid directly to the successful student, with part-time students eligible for a pro-rata payment. To enhance their student experience and potential for career development, the holder of the scholarship will have the opportunity to become involved in the College's race equality work.

## The Application Process

In order to apply for the College of Arts Minority Ethnic Studentship, it is important that you:

- Hold an offer of study for a postgraduate taught programme within the College of Arts
- Be classed as a UK-permanent resident of a Black, Asian or Minority Ethnic background
- Fully complete the enclosed scholarship application form, and submit this by 31 August 2022

## The Selection Process

The University of Lincoln College of Arts Minority Ethnic Studentship will be awarded to the scholarship applicant who demonstrates the highest levels of academic, personal and extracurricular endeavour. Upon close of the studentship deadline, the University will assess each application carefully, and will endeavour to notify all candidates of a decision on or prior to 10 working days of the application closing date.

## Awarding of the Studentship

The successful candidate will be notified by email. Upon enrolment the studentship will be paid directly to the student, with part-time students eligible for a pro-rata payment.

- 1. The College of Arts Minority Ethnic Studentship will take the form of £2500 will be paid directly to the student, with part-time students eligible for a pro-rata payment.**
- 2. University of Lincoln Studentships are non-transferable and are not valid in conjunction with each other; only one Scholarship per student per Programme of Study will be applied. The studentship will only be applied during the first year of enrolment for full-time students; scholarships will not be applied to any subsequent years of study. However, part-time students will be eligible for a pro-rata payment.**
- 3. The University of Lincoln reserves the right to amend or withdraw the College of Arts Minority Ethnic Studentship at any point and without notice.**
- 4. To be eligible for the College of Arts Minority Ethnic Studentship applicants must be a UK- permanent resident of a Black, Asian or Minority Ethnic background when enrolling on one of the Postgraduate (Taught) programmes in the College of Arts. The following ethnic groups are considered as minority ethnic:**

  - Asian - Bangladeshi
  - Asian - Chinese
  - Asian - Indian
  - Asian - Other
  - Asian - Pakistani
  - Black - African
  - Black - Caribbean
  - Black - Other

- 5. Candidates must already hold a Conditional or Unconditional Offer from the University of Lincoln for an eligible Postgraduate Taught Programme of Study commencing in 2020 within the College of Arts.**
  - 6. Candidates must complete and submit a College of Arts Minority Ethnic Studentship Application Form no later than 4pm (UK time) on 31 August 2022. Applications received after this deadline will not be considered. Applications should be submitted to Lisa Wherrell IWherrell@lincoln.ac.uk College of Arts Executive Office.**
  - 7. College of Arts Minority Ethnic Studentship will be awarded to scholarship applicant who demonstrates the highest levels of academic, personal and extracurricular endeavour. This will be based on the contents of the Scholarship Application Form alongside academic grades submitted as part of the application process to the University of Lincoln.**
  - 8. College of Arts Minority Ethnic Studentship awards cannot be deferred to subsequent intakes.**
  - 9. The University reserves the right to use the names of scholarship award winners, their photographs and audio and/or visual recordings in publicity and marketing materials.**
  - 10. The scholarship is exclusively for the Student selected, and is neither transferable nor \ exchangeable.**
