Environmental Scholarship 2022 - Terms and Conditions

The Environmental Scholarship 2022 (the “Scholarship”) is organised by the University of Lincoln, UK (the “University”).

All information provided by entrants to the Scholarship will be maintained and processed in accordance with UK Data Protection legislation.

The Scholarship is open to anyone aged 18 years or older at the time of entering unless excluded by these Terms and Conditions (the “Rules”). By applying for the Scholarship, you confirm that you understand and agree to accept these Rules.

The Scholarship opens for applications on 1st November 2021 and closes at midnight (BST) on 30th September 2022.

A single entrant can enter the scholarship for each application submitted.

To be eligible for the scholarship, entrants must submit an application to the University of Lincoln for a full-time Masters course worth 180 credits, and be accepted for a place on the course.

Additionally, they must complete a scholarship application at a Postgraduate Open Event before the 30th September 2022, by writing a paragraph about how being awarded the scholarship would enable them to be an environmental champion. A single winner will be selected from all entrants who are judged to have submitted applications during the timeframe.

The University cannot accept any responsibility for any damage, loss, injury or disappointment suffered by any person entering the Scholarship.

The University reserves the right both to cancel the Scholarship and to amend these Rules where it is deemed necessary or to account for circumstances beyond its control. Any notice of cancellation or changes to the Rules will be posted on the University of Lincoln website.

In the event of any dispute regarding these Rules or any other matter relating to the Scholarship, the decision of the University shall be final and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into.

Entries or entrants not complying with the Rules will be disqualified.

Entrants must submit a valid scholarship application to the University of Lincoln at a postgraduate open event, providing their real name, age and a valid email address with their submission. Entries cannot be accepted by other means. The University accepts no liability for non-receipt of any entry.

You may withdraw your entry by email notification to competitions@lincoln.ac.uk.

The University reserves the right to withdraw any entry which it considers to be prejudicial to the interests or reputation of the University or its stakeholders.

There is no fee for entry to the Scholarship.

One scholarship will be awarded to the selected winner of a £3000 Environmental Scholarship for postgraduate taught study.

All scholarships are non-transferable and no alternative will be offered.

The scholarship valued at £3000 (“the Scholarship”) is redeemable against University of Lincoln postgraduate programmes starting in October 2022 only. The winner must apply for, and be accepted on, their chosen full-time Master’s programme of study at the University of Lincoln in order to redeem the scholarship. The scholarship will be paid to the winner in three £1000 instalments upon completion of each 60 credit element. The scholarship cannot be exchanged for cash or be refunded in the form of a cash payment should the student subsequently withdraw from the programme. The University reserves the right not to award the scholarship, or to reduce or alter the prize if, in their opinion, such action is justified for any reason.

The winner will be selected after the close of the scholarship on 30th September 2022. The winning entry will be notified by email using the contact details provided on the Postgraduate Scholarship Application. Unsuccessful entrants will not be notified of the outcome of the Scholarship.

If the selected winner cannot be contacted or does not respond to contact within 10 working days they will forfeit the scholarship, which may be allocated to another entrant at the discretion of the University.

Current employees of the University of Lincoln cannot enter the Scholarship. Students and alumni are eligible to enter.

The scholarship will be governed by English law and any dispute will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
