# Helping the Doctors of the Future Realise Their Potential



In September 2019, the University of Lincoln will welcome its first medical students to the Brayford Pool Campus as part of an exciting collaboration with the University of Nottingham to offer medical education in Lincolnshire.

Lincoln Medical School aims to deliver medical training to 80 students each year, building on the many new healthcare related programmes – including nursing, physiotherapy, and midwifery – introduced by the University of Lincoln in recent years. In addition, a foundation programme designed to widen access to medical study will offer 15 students an alternative pathway into the study of medicine.

The Medical School seeks to inspire young people from local schools, give them more opportunities to train as doctors, and encourage them to remain in the area once they have qualified.

The University of Lincoln is proud of its record for widening participation in higher education, with a high proportion of our students coming from families with no previous experience of going to university. We will continue to help young people across Greater Lincolnshire and beyond to unlock their potential to become doctors and other professionals.

# How You Can Help

We would ask you to consider helping the doctors of the future by contributing to a bursary fund to support students from low-income backgrounds to study medicine at Lincoln. We would like to be able to offer means-tested bursary funding of up to £5,000 per year per student, targeted at those from less advantaged backgrounds, to pay for their living costs during their time at the University. Our goal is to raise a fund of at least £30,000 to provide bursaries in the first year.

## Please help us to support the doctors of the future.
