Congratulations on your exam results! We are extremely pleased to unconditionally accept you onto your course starting in October 2020.

TO ENROL ONTO YOUR COURSE

You are required to complete the following:

- Step 1 - Check and amend your Personal Details
-Upload Verification ID (this should be photo ID - your passport, driving licence or college ID)
- Step 2 - Upload a photo for your student ID card (not your passport or driving licence)
- Step 3 – We will contact you in October to confirm your enrolment on your course ready for the first day of teaching.

To complete Step 1 and 2 you will need to access Enrol.Lincoln. You will need to change your password first, read the instructions below and then click the link to login.

- Click the link below
- Click on 'First time here?', then Click here to Set Password" button
- When the "Get Back into your account" page appears, enter your student email address in the User ID box as displayed and follow the instructions to change your password.

Once you receive an email from the University, you will have your student email address to start the process above.

YOUR STUDENT CARD

As part of updating your details on Enrol.Lincoln we will ask you to upload photographic verification ID, this should be your passport, driving licence or college ID. We require this photo ID to compare against the photo you provide in Step 2 of the enrolment process to produce your student ID card. This is to ensure that your card is ready for collection when you arrive on campus.

Find out what to expect during your first week at Lincoln. To prepare you for your first week of teaching, the University of Lincoln has prepared an Online Orientation Week for you to access prior to arrival. This timetable provides live and recorded information from your College/School including induction activities scheduled for your course. There are also activities scheduled from the Students' Union and Support Departments across the University, including the Library, Careers, Student Support and our Student Wellbeing Team.
